Removal of Community Park Picnic Shelter

Parksville, BC — The picnic shelter in the Parksville Community Park will be dismantled and removed this week because it is now in a state of disrepair.

The extensive damage to the picnic shelter caused from insect, bird and general dampness is typical of a structure of this age and type. It has been determined that it is more feasible to build a new structure as the extent of the repairs required to make the structure sound would be comparable to the construction of a new shelter.

In the spring, a new structure will be built and an amount of \$75,000 for reconstruction will be included in the 2011 provisional financial plan. The new shelter will be built to resemble the form and function of the new waterfront features and provide the ability to further tie-in the Community Park theme.
