(Transportation, getting around the way youth do)

(Youth economics, youth poverty, youth income inequality, housing, jobs)

Getting Connected

(Two-way communication with youth, organizations, being engaged)

Our Island on the Edge

(Parksville as part of a bigger world, sustainability, growth, demographics)
