REGIONAL DISTRICT OF NANAIMO SEEKS APPLICANTS FOR NORTHERN COMMUNITY ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT FUNDING

The Regional District of Nanaimo invites business and community groups in District 69 to submit proposals for funding under the Northern Community Economic Development program. This newly-established program provides support for economic development initiatives in the City of Parksville, the Town of Qualicum Beach and Electoral Areas 'E', 'F', 'G', and 'H'.

"The Northern Community Economic Development Program allows the RDN Board of Directors to contribute to eligible projects that advance the Board's vision for a resilient, thriving and creative local economy," explained RDN Chairperson Joe Stanhope, who also chairs the Northern Community Economic Development Select Committee.

Project proposals can be submitted at any time, and will be considered by the Committee twice annually. To be considered in the next round, submissions must be received by 4:30 pm on April 30, 2012.
