Official Opening of McMillan Street

Today was the official opening of McMillan Street following an extensive upgrade. Parksville Mayor Chris Burger and members of Council were joined by staff from Windley Contracting and Koers Engineering, ICBC representative and clients from the Parksville and District Association for Community Living for a photo opportunity.

The upgrade project involved reconstruction, widening and upgrading of roadway along McMillan Street, from Island Highway 19A West, south through the Hirst Avenue intersection. The project included significant safety improvements for vehicles, bicyclists and pedestrians, as well as undergrounding of overhead utility lines and streetscape amenities. Some of the project's key features include two pedestrian signals, wide sidewalks, bike lanes, decorative street lights, street trees and a new traffic signal at the Hirst Avenue intersection.
