Highway 19A - Moilliet Street to West of Pym Street Public Information Session - October 10, 2012

As part of ongoing transportation planning and improvements to Highway 19A, the City of Parksville recently completed a traffic study which evaluated the Highway 19A corridor between the intersections of Moilliet Street and Bay Avenue.

The City of Parksville will hold a public information session to review the project's findings. The information session will be held on October 10, 2012, in the Forum, Parksville Civic and Technology Centre. All residents are encouraged to drop by between 6 pm and 8 pm to learn more about this project.

The traffic study determined the optimal road improvements which are necessary between Bay Avenue and Moilliet Street to improve public safety and enhance network connectivity. The project also included an evaluation of the corridor to determine the scope, estimated cost, and phasing to upgrade 19A from Roscow Street to approximately 300 meters west of the Pym Street intersection to the City's current urban arterial road standard.
