Foster care provides children with a family setting and a safe, loving and stable environment when their own parents are not able to look after them. Around 35 per cent of children in care who are adopted are adopted by their foster family.

"Foster families open their hearts and homes to provide care to children in need. The City is pleased to honour the remarkable contribution that foster parents make to the children and families in our own community" said Mayor Chris Burger.
