

OPENING FOR ADVISORY PLANNING COMMISSION MEMBERS

The City is inviting interested individuals to submit an application for appointment to the Advisory Planning Commission.

The term of office for several members of the Advisory Planning Commission (APC) will end December 31, 2012. At this time the City will consider applications for new members as well as the existing members for the two-year term, 2013 to 2014. Commission members are appointed pursuant to Section 898 of the *Local Government Act* and serve without remuneration.

The function of the seven member APC is to advise Council on matters respecting land use and community planning that are referred to the Commission by Council. Applicants with experience in land use planning, architectural design or related fields would be an asset, although this is not a prerequisite.
