Temple Street Upgrade - Bay Avenue to West of Phillips Street Public Information Session - March 28, 2013

As part of ongoing capital upgrades and infrastructure renewal, the City of Parksville and consultants recently completed a preliminary design review of the Temple Street corridor from Bay Avenue to west of Phillips Street. The purpose was to analyse and produce an optimized road cross section on which to develop detailed design drawings for construction of the corridor.

The City of Parksville will hold a public information session to review the findings. The information session will be held on Thursday, March 28, 2013, in the Forum at the Parksville Civic and Technology Centre. All residents are encouraged to drop by between 5 pm and 8 pm to learn more about this project.

The Temple Street upgrade is about 2,000 meters long and includes the addition of missing infrastructure, the upgrading of older infrastructure and provision of a continuous pedestrian facility. The capital upgrade is currently scheduled for 2013 and 2014.
