Temple Street upgrade - Bay Avenue to west of Phillips Street Public information session - October 2

The City of Parksville has scheduled a second public information session on Wednesday, October 2 to review the proposed upgrade of the Temple Street corridor from Bay Avenue to west of Phillips Street, about 2,000 meters.

The City received input from the public in March and has now reviewed with the consultant, the comments in an attempt to reconcile with the proposed design. This open house will address these concerns and provide further information on plans to upgrade Temple Street. Construction plans include new and upgraded infrastructure and the provision of a continuous pedestrian route. The project is scheduled for construction in 2014.

Residents are encouraged to drop by between 4 pm and 7 pm to learn more about this project and provide further comments. The information session will be held in the Forum at the Parksville Civic and Technology Centre.
