

Community Park Playground Equipment

Over the next few weeks, some of the playground equipment in the Community Park's Lions Ventureland Playground will be replaced. The play equipment is being removed because of the age of the equipment, cost to maintain in working condition or because it no longer meets standards for playgrounds.

The carousel, twin seesaws, sand diggers, geodesic dome and the toddler blue and yellow square play structure will be permanently removed. The helicopter climbing structure has been removed for repairs and will be replaced when complete.

The new equipment includes new seesaws, two new diggers (one wheelchair accessible) as well as this equipment shown here:
