Temple Street Paving Preparation and Paving to Begin

As part of the City's capital upgrades and infrastructure renewal plan, the Temple Street Phase 1 upgrade is well underway. This winter's mild weather has allowed completion of underground utilities and servicing from Sunray Road to Chinook Avenue. Road reconstruction, concrete curb, gutter and sidewalks from Chinook to Pym Street are now substantially complete. Landscaping, grading, curb, gutter and sidewalk from Pym Street to Sunray Road are underway and will be completed soon, followed by road reconstruction, landscaping and pavement.

Beginning on Monday, April 13, paving preparation followed by pavement placement will start at Chinook Avenue and will continue through mid-May to Sunray Road (weather dependent).

The contractor has been instructed to communicate with residents regarding disruptions. As with all construction projects, please expect minor inconveniences or delays. We ask that you follow the directions provided by flaggers and the contractor.

The City wishes to thank residents for their patience and understanding during this construction. Phase 1 will be substantially complete in June and the project is on time and on budget.
