## **Craig Street Upgrades Postponed**

The work planned for Craig Street to be started this week has been postponed until the fall. The upgrade work was announced by the City last week and will now be completed in fall 2015.

In the fall, the work will include the removal of all existing exposed aggregate concrete wheelchair and driveway ramps, re-installation of City of Parksville standard wheelchair and driveway ramps, the installation of a new crosswalk and wheelchair ramp at the corner of Middleton Avenue and Craig Street and the complete resurfacing and remarking of the roadway.

The pedestrian upgrades will significantly improve the delineation between the level sidewalk and wheelchair and driveway ramps for the vision impaired as well as improve access safety for the mobility challenged. These upgrades are in line with the pedestrian safety recommendations provided by the Municipal Insurance Association of British Columbia specifically for the City of Parksville.
