Water Conservation Non-Compliance Fines

Parksville, BC – At last evening's meeting, City of Parksville Council gave final reading to a bylaw which authorizes the City's bylaw compliance officers to ticket residents not in compliance with the City's water conservation restrictions.

Water Service System Amendment Bylaw, 2015, No. 1320.25 passed by Council on July 20 makes the contravention of water conservation regulations a ticketable offence. Fines will be as follows:

| Connection to water system without written permission | \$150 |
|---|-------|
| Use of water contrary to conservation levels | \$100 |
| Allow waste of water | \$100 |
| Failure to use water in accordance with the provisions of the bylaw | \$100 |
| Obstructing a City employee or officer | \$400 |

On July 8, the City of Parksville along with the Regional District of Nanaimo, moved to a Comprehensive Watering Ban (Level 4 Conservation). The City's bylaw compliance officers and operations department water patrol staff through public information materials and warnings are working to obtain compliance from residents prior to ticketing.
