Councillor Greir Resigns from City of Parksville Council

On July 11, Councillor Al Greir advised Mayor Marc Lefebvre he was resigning from Council due to health reasons. Councillor Greir was first elected to Council in 2009 and was re-elected in 2012 and again in 2014.

Councillor Greir stated in his letter of resignation, "I have enjoyed my eight years on Council and have done my best to serve the residents of Parksville in an honest and positive way. I have felt honored to represent all the residents of Parksville, and only wish I could have accomplished more."

Mayor Marc Lefebvre commented, "Councillor Greir will be missed and I've always appreciate his frankness and positions on issues where he has the best interests of the citizens of Parksville at heart. On behalf of Council, we wish him good health and the very best in the future."
