Community Park Tourists to be Surveyed in July

The City of Parksville continues to work with Vancouver Island University to gather input from residents and tourists to create a vision for the Parksville Community Park. Consultation started in March with the *Parks on the Street* event, followed by a *World Café, Picnic Table Talks, Gazebo Talks* and a resident survey.

The next phase in consultation includes a tourist survey scheduled for four Fridays and Saturdays during July, beginning on July 7. On those days, students from VIU will be stationed in the Community Park to speak with visitors from outside the Parksville area to capture their perspectives and visions for the park. We hope this will provide an opportunity for tourists to provide input and suggestions on the future of the Community Park.

Information gathered during the tourist survey, along with other public engagement activities, will be presented to Council in the fall. The final document will provide direction for development of the Community Park over the next twenty-years.
