Arbutus Point Restoration Work Now Complete

The City's beach protection work near the labyrinth at Arbutus Point in the Parksville Community Park has now been completed successfully and on time by the contractor, Parksville Heavy Equipment.

This restoration work was necessary to protect the beach from the effects of erosion. The project which will result in a more sustainable shoreline involved an 850 square metre area of Parksville Bay. The Arbutus Point work included placement of riprap, granular beach fill, ballasted large logs as well as the removal of an existing lock-block seawall and installation of ten metres of storm pipe.

To comply with environmental regulations, we were given a four week window in August and are pleased the work was completed well ahead of schedule. We do realize this is a busy time of the summer for the Community Park and sincerely appreciate the patience and cooperation of our residents and visitors during construction.
