Survey for Parksville Residents on City-wide Ban on Single-use Plastic Bags

For environmental reasons, the City of Parksville is considering implementing a ban on the use of single-use plastic carryout bags within City limits. The purpose of this survey is to gather information and opinions from residents and retailers on the use of single-use plastic carryout bags to determine if there is support for a Citywide ban on plastic bags.

The survey includes questions for both residents and business owners in the City of Parksville.
