

Christmas is Coming to the City

On Tuesday, November 14 and Wednesday, November 15, City crews will install Christmas lights on the trees on Alberni Highway, on the Sequoia tree on Morison and at the Parksville Civic and Technology Centre. At Council's direction, there will be twice as many lights as previous years installed on Alberni Highway and on the Sequoia.

Crews will be working from 7.30 am to 3.30 pm on November 14 and November 15 with a number of trucks deployed. For this reason, parking will be extremely limited on the Alberni Highway. Crews will work in unison on the Alberni Highway:

- Starting at the CIBC at Highway 19A, crews will work on the west side moving up the Alberni
- Starting near the Royal Bank, crews will work on the east side moving down the Alberni Highway.

Once crews have installed the lights on the trees, parking spaces will come available again.

It may well seem early for the installation of lights; however, we are keen to have the work completed for the Parksville Downtown Business Association light-up event scheduled for Friday, November 24 at 5.30 pm.
