Work Continues in Parksville Wetlands

City of Parksville parks crews continue to work in the Parksville Wetlands recently completing a trail connection from Foxtail Avenue to Hirst Avenue.

At this time, the new trail now has a rough rock base and a finer trail crush will be added next week with trail signage to follow. When complete, this trail will connect the Hirst/Renz corner to Chestnut and Despard almost one kilometre in distance.

A planting program will begin in the spring to repair the disturbed areas and to also replace plant material in the areas where City crews removed two tandem truckloads of broom.
